I. Major Work Areas

- A. In the month of June, there were several issues with tractor trailers being operated down Ohio Street. Officers on Sergeant Carter's crew also responded to a hit and run incident where a tractor trailer hit a City of Augusta traffic sign and a City of Augusta employee. Officers will focus on enforcing truck route violations for month of July.
- B. As Sergeant Hagman's shift rolls into night shift, they will monitor traffic in residential neighborhoods to curtail the vehicle burglaries that have been occurring recently.
- C. Officer Meckel will oversee the kickoff of the Bugs Bunny Club starting Saturday, July 9; and will continue through the planning phase for the "Movie in the Park" function slated for August.
- D. Lieutenant Johnston and Sergeant Scheuber will begin inventorying the various firearms stored in ADPS property / evidence and will work toward entering them in the new PMI Evidence system.
- E. Officers will continue checking the restrooms at Dalton Palmer Park. Some of the vandalisms are occurring during the daylight hours.
- F. Due to the construction on Ohio Street, there have been several citizen complaints on Facebook of the high traffic, and speeding/reckless driving, occurring in the Danbury neighborhood. There have also been complaints of speeding and wrong way drivers in the construction zone. Officer assigned to Sergeant Carter's shift will spend extra time patrolling these neighborhoods and issuing violations seen in this area along with the construction zone.
- G. Sergeant Hagman's shift will continue to focus on patrolling the city lake and enforcing fishing regulations there.

II. Accomplishments

- A. Officer Orocio responded to a disturbance involving a suicidal subject armed with a knife. Officer Orocio was able to contact the subject and get him to discard the knife. He then spent time talking with him and determined that he was just upset over a breakup and not suicidal.
- B. Officer Hatcher initiated a traffic stop on a vehicle that had an expired license plate. Officer Hatcher was able to find out, through asking investigative questions, that the license plate did not belong on that vehicle, and it actually belonged to a subject who had passed away several months prior. The person in possession of the license plate was not in lawful possession of it.

Officer Hatcher seized the license plate so that the subject driving the vehicle could not continue to drive on an illegal tag.

- C. Officer Sisco completed his field training observation with Sergeant Carter and Officer Sisco graduated from the FTO program to be released on his own. Way to go Officer Sisco and congratulations!
- D. Lieutenant Johnston met with a United States Secret Service Agent with the Wichita office and established a process of sending previously seized counterfeit money currently stored in ADPS property / evidence to the USSS office for identification and disposition.
- E. Officer Weber worked two burglaries and was able to identify the suspects on both the burglaries. Officer Weber able to identify a female on the first burglary and interviewed her and got the suspects information. The other burglary Officer Weber immediately recognized the suspect. Both cases will be sent to the county attorney for prosecution.
- F. Officers had multiple encounters with a subject going through a mental health crisis. Officer Brown and Sergeant Hagman's previous Crisis Intervention training was beneficial in determining the best course of action in dealing with the subject. Over several encounters, Officers worked on the best plan in dealing with him while protecting his rights and considering the families concerns and welfare. Eventually the subject met the threshold needed for police protective custody and he was transported to the hospital for treatment.
- G. Sergeant Scheuber assisted patrol in investigating a complex fraud case which involved a local woman accused of stealing over \$40,000.00 from a local elderly male. The initial investigation led to the discovery of fifteen other incidents against the same victim by the same suspect. The investigation is ongoing.

- A. We have filled all of our Safety Officer positions and are now waiting for them to graduate the Law Enforcement Academy.
- B. We are in the process of hiring and training new dispatchers.

- D. We picked up a sign trailer from Haysville PD to use on North Ohio Street for temporary closures.
- E. I attended an Outlaw Biker Gang meeting in Gardner, KS.
- F. I attended and sat on a law enforcement administrators panel at the KPAS school at KLETC.
- G. I am meeting with and have been working on a city-wide project proposal with 4PC Security.
