I. Major Work Areas

- A. Officer Brown's team will be focusing on school zones, before and after school.
- B. Sergeant Hagman's team will be focusing on problems areas where a number of catalytic converter thefts have occurred.
- C. SRO Sergeant Meckel will begin planning for the 2023 Bugs Bunny Club festivities planned for the month of March.

II. Accomplishments

- A. Retired ADPS Captain Bruce Relph, Detective Sergeant Scheuber and Lieutenant Johnston all testified in Butler County District Court at a jury trial stemming from a 2021 homicide investigation. The jury ultimately found the defendant guilty of First Degree Murder. The convicted faces sentencing in early March 2023.
- B. Detective Sergeant Scheuber began a "Fugitive Friday" social media campaign on the Augusta CrimeStoppers Facebook page, in an effort to locate and apprehend those with active arrest warrants through the City of Augusta Municipal Court.
- C. Officer Coffman conducted a traffic stop with an individual who was known to be driving while suspended. Officer Coffman also knew of previous drug involvement with the driver. Officer Coffman requested a K-9 to his location. Andover PD provided a K-9, who indicated on the vehicle during an open-air sniff. During the search of the vehicle, Officer Coffman found anabolic steroids, methamphetamine, pills that contained fentanyl, along with drug paraphernalia. Officer Coffman arrested the driver on several drug charges, along with driving while suspended.
- D. Officers were dispatched to a report of a man under a carport, attempting to break into cars. The subject was on scene when Officer Orocio and Sgt Hagman arrived. They approached from opposite directions and took the subject by surprise. Officers found that he had stolen a security camera from the residence. He was arrested and charged with theft.
- E. Officer Cosby assisted in identifying several suspects in a string of vandalisms in town. Officer Cosby was able to contact the suspects parents and were able to interview the suspects who admitted to the vandalisms.

- F. Officers Brown and Coffman assisted Sergeant Strobbe and his shift, with serving a search warrant in the 200 block of E. 6th. Officer Brown assisted with clearing the house once entry was made. Officer Coffman eventually transported a female suspect to the station for drug related charges. Prosecution is being requested on these charges pending test results. Officer Brown remained on scene to provide scene security while other officers conducted a search of the residence.
- G. Officers were dispatched to a vehicle stuck on the railroad tracks on S Walnut. An elderly woman had driven her car approximately 30 yards down the tracks and got high centered. Officers were able to contact BNSF and get train traffic stopped. Dave's Towing was called to get the car removed from the tracks and the scene was turned over to the Butler County Sheriff's Department.
- H. Sergeant Meckel attended a "Think Before Your Post" presentation at AHS and AMS. TBYP is an all-grade assembly focusing on the dangers and potential consequences of posting on social media.
- I. Sergeant Strobbe finished up a drug investigation and was granted a search warrant of the suspect's house. Multiple items of drugs paraphernalia and some drugs were found.
- J. Safety Officer Hatcher was conducting surveillance in the 400 block of Osage due to drug traffic in the area. He observed a vehicle with an illegal tag and conducted a traffic stop. The driver was found to be driving while suspended and was found to be in possession of marijuana. The driver was arrested for possession of marijuana and driving while their license is suspended.
- K. Officers assigned to Sergeant Weber's crew responded to the report of a woman who had given birth to a 15-week-old premature infant. Officers arrived on scene prior to EMS and assisted EMS with transporting the newborn baby.
- L. Officers Brown and Coffman were dispatched to Dollar General for the report of shoplifting in progress. Officers made contact with store employees who advised that a female suspect had placed items in her purse. Officers made contact with the female suspect outside of the store, where they found that suspect had disposed of the items prior to leaving the store. During the investigation, it was also found that the female suspect had also disposed of a small baggie of methamphetamine in the same area as the merchandise. Suspect was arrested on related drug charges.
- M. Officer Sisco did a great job of arresting a suspect on felony charges that initially was refusing to come of the apartment. Officer Sisco patiently waited and was able to gain access and arrest the guy with no property damage.
