I. Accomplishments / Highlights

- A. Throughout the month, Officer Coffman made seven drug law violation arrests. Out of those arrests, two suspects were juveniles. Officer Coffman removed 12 THC vape cartridges, and 6 grams of marijuana, along with several items of drug paraphernalia from the streets.
- B. Officer Brown interviewed a suspect in connection with a burglary report taken in March in the 400 block of State. After completing the interview, the suspect was arrested and charged with burglary. The suspect was processed and transported to the Butler County Jail.
- C. Sergeant Hagman was contacted by staff at Cooper Drug. A subject had called in a fraudulent prescription. Sergeant Hagman began working with Cooper staff to arrest the suspect when he arrived to get the medication. The suspect showed up on a later date and was arrested by Officer Orocio and other on-duty Officers that day.
- D. Officer Cosby worked her second DUI when she found a vehicle in the roadway and the driver was passed out with her foot on the brake. The driver was offered SFST and subsequently arrested on suspicion of DUI. The driver blew over the limit when offered the Intoxilyzer test.
- E. Reserve Officer Vance assisted with working on the Memorial holiday weekend and found a suspicious vehicle with an expired tag. When stopped the driver was found to have a suspended license and two warrants out of Allen County. Officer Vance arrested the driver without incident.
- F. Officers were dispatched to the 500 block of Santa Fe for the report of a person not breathing due to a fentanyl overdose. Officer Hatcher arrived on the scene and administered Narcan to the unconscious person. The person then started breathing and was conscious. The person was then transported by EMS.
- G. Fire departmental personnel responded to a mutual aid request from the Andover Fire Department to assist with a residential structure fire. The fire resulted in the death of one citizen.
- H. Fire department personnel responded to a motor vehicle crash on K-254 and River Valley. One victim was pinned in the vehicle and was quickly extricated and turned over to EMS for treatment.

- I. Fire department personnel responded to a report of a person on fire east of the city. When we arrived, we found an elderly male subject face down in a pile of burning brush. The male was smoldering and was extinguished, and an investigation was conducted. It was determined the male was burning the brush and fell off a motorized scooter into the fire. The subject died of burn injuries.

- J. Lieutenant Johnston, Sergeant Scheuber, and KLEAP Accreditation Manager Amanda Cole finished the documentation process for the first round of guns from the ADPS property and evidence storage facility that is now slated for trade-in for new duty handguns for commissioned officers.
