I. Accomplishments / Highlights

- A. Officers were dispatched for the report of two juvenile runaways. During the investigation it was found that the two runaways were with another runaway from Wichita. Officers spoke with an individual, who was possibly with the runaways. Officer Brown asked dispatch to check FLOCK for the individual's vehicle. The vehicle was tracked, which led officers to eventually stop the vehicle. During the stop, all three runaways were found in the vehicle. The driver of the vehicle was arrested for contributing to a child misconduct; failure to reveal a runaway, along with criminal carry of a weapon.
- B. Officer Brown and Officer Smith assisted Butler County Sheriff with two individuals that fled the scene out in the county, where there was a disturbance with shots fired. The suspect vehicle attempted to elude deputies prior to wrecking at 2nd and Walnut. Officers assisted deputies in arresting the suspects, where they faced a series of charges in relation to the disturbance.
- C. Officers responded to a woman who jumped in front of a moving vehicle. The woman was located and was found to be in a mental health crisis and highly intoxicated. While attempted to place her into police protective custody, the woman physically resisted. She was charged with Battery LEO among other charges and then transported to St. Joseph for a mental health evaluation.
- D. Officer Cosby stopped a suspicious vehicle and found four teens outside past curfew. The owner of the vehicle could not be contacted so the vehicle was impounded, and the teens were cited and released to parents. It was discovered later that the teens had burglarized a house in the county and stole the car. Because Officer Cosby was looking into the situation and not releasing the car to a parent, she assisted the county with identifying the suspects of their burglary.
- E. Sergeant Strobbe worked on a trespassing case and after investigating found the suspect had been served eviction notice. The suspect was arrested without incident. The suspect was given information for resources for the homeless.
- F. Sergeant Weber was dispatched to the report of a hit and run at 6th and Walnut where a semi had struck a streetlight. The truck could not be located. The caller was an off-duty officer who had given a good description of the truck. The trucking company had called to speak with Sergeant Weber on his days off. The trucking company had found on the day of the accident they had a worker come in with a damaged trailer. The worker said he had hit a deer. The trucking company did not believe his story and had found out we were working a hit and run with one of their trucks. The trucking company shared the pictures they had

taken. Looking at the photos and damage it was determined it was the truck involved in the accident. Prosecution was requested on the driver.

- G. Sergeant Weber and Lieutenant Johnston responded to the report of a forgery in progress at 112 W. 7th Ave. at Intrust Bank. Once on scene it was determined the lady in the bank was trying to pass a fictitious check. She was arrested, processed, and taken to the Butler County Jail. During the investigation it was found the Butler County Sheriff Dept. was investigating the suspect for a theft. Once at the station an investigator with the Butler County Sheriff Dept. interviewed the suspect on the theft.
